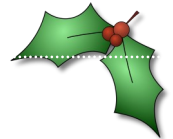

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 All Show classes are only open to regular producers, who must have presented or sold through York Auction Centre fatstock or storestock at least three times during the year.
- 2 Class 8 is open to any young producers who is not over 21 years old at the day of the show and who also complies with the conditions above in either their own name or through the family business. Sheep entered in class 8 also qualify for classes 9-11.
- 3 There will be no entrance fee and entries can be made on this form.
- 4 All cattle entered for the show can be haltered or if not haltered capable of being handled by the judge.
- 5 Stock which has won or been placed at other local Fatstock Shows will not be eligible.
- 6 Stock must have been in the ownership of the entrant for at least eight weeks. Cattle passports must be handed to the auctioneers on arrival. Cattle with incorrect passports cannot be shown or sold.
- 7 Show stock must be in the Market by 8.30am on the morning of the show.
