Biosecurity Declaration: I, hereby declare that I have read and will comply with the biosecurity information overleaf and to the best of my knowledge, my birds have not been in contact with any notifiable avian disease and do not show any signs of infection

NOTES

- All poultry & equipment unsold and uncollected by 1 hour after the sale will be disposed of by the auctioneers at the vendor’s expense. Please ensure proper arrangements have been made to collect your poultry & equipment if not sold.
- I hereby instruct York Auction Centre to sell by auction on my behalf the goods as detailed above subject to the terms stated.
- The auction is governed by the normal “Conditions of Sale” – see reverse
- No lots will be accepted for sale after 9.30am on the day of sale. Vendors to be limited to a maximum of 20 lots per sale.
- Vendors commission is charged at 12.5% + VAT

I, have read and will comply with the biosecurity information overleaf and to the best of my knowledge, my birds have not been in contact with any notifiable avian disease agents and do not show any signs of infection and the address of the premises of origin of the birds, with confirmation that the birds do not originate from a premises under restriction for a poultry disease or from within a protection, surveillance or other notifiable avian disease controlled zone or from an avian influenza prevention zone.

POULTRY HEALTH DECLARATION

On signing this declaration overleaf you are agreeing to our conditions of sale as follows:

- a) You are confirming that the poultry you are presenting for sale are in good health and are from disease free stock.
- b) All stock should be checked prior to loading and placed in clean crates or boxes for travelling to this market
- c) The birds should not have originated from premises or areas which are under restrictions related to confirmation of a notifiable avian disease.
(Please see Defra website for details or see our map.)
- d) All vendors must hold a valid account number which must be entered prior to entry. This can be obtained from the accounts office
- e) When booking in poultry you will be allocated the requested number of pens. Please place your stock in these pens only. PLEASE DO NOT EMPTY YOUR BOXES OR CRATES THAT MAY CONTAIN POULTRY FAECAL MATERIAL WITHIN OUR AUCTION AREA.
- f) All cages, crates and carrying boxes must be removed from the auction area as soon as the birds have been penned.
- g) Disposable boxes should be deposited in the bins provided at the entrance of the poultry area. Carrying crates can be washed out at the wash-down area located at the lorry wash.
- h) Please use the hand washing facilities provided and the biosecurity foot baths when entering and exiting the poultry areas.
- i) Poultry will be checked and any stock found to be unfit will be withdrawn. Stock suspected of carrying the Avian Flu disease will be subject to a vet inspection and the area will be closed to all movements, all costs incurred will be chargeable to the Vendor including the cost of additional bio-security procedures needed to be carried out on site.
- j) It is recommended that poultry returning to your holding are placed in isolation for 7 days.
