FATSTOCK REPORT

FAT CATTLE

Numbers are holding up quite well but we are still getting reports back of consumer resistance which isn't helping the trade in the ring.

This week we should slip 3-5p on most categories but our show of 307 cattle in total was good for the time of year. It was made up of 139 clean, 124 bulls and 46 OTM's. The averages for the Continentals hovered around 195p/kg and in the bull section the highest price went to P R Walker with an outstanding home-bred Limousin bull making 220p/kg.

J A Sellers with another Limousin hit 218p, Maxwell Brothers 217p and Les Thompson 215p. Just behind them was Doug Shirt with a 754kg bull making 214p/kg and adding up to £1609.

On a headage basis also Derek Pickering had a bull at £1551, Dick Brown £1544.

The black and white bulls averaged around 160p/kg with the best shaped Friesians making up to 186p from Guy Cowling with Richard Button on 183p, Doug Shirt 178p and Mark Nicholson 176p/kg.

Clean trade wasn't perhaps as sharply affected with some nice quality cattle making up to a top of 235p for an outstanding British Blue heifer bred by John Rycroft. H P Lawson was next in line with a steer making 230p/kg then John Rycroft had two more home-bred sucklers make 228 and 229p respectively.

Pete Johnson had a heifer on 228p a well with Chris Rook hitting 227p/kg.

The OTM's were this week headed up by Graham Stephenson who had two overage Limousins make 168 and 175p respectively.

Rob Hall then had two Charolais' similar make 162 and 165p with David Etherington having his stock bull make 160p/kg.
