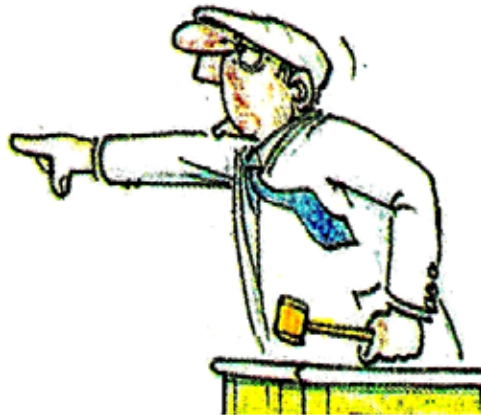

Fat cattle supplies are getting scarce everywhere and it is perhaps no bad thing with reports of poor demand at the consumer end.

Nevertheless we maintained a decent show on Monday with 211 cattle forward of which 102 were bulls, 83 clean and 26 OTM's.

The bull trade was pretty similar to last week and the continentals averaged 198p through the market.

Anthony Turnbull hit the top spot this week with an outstanding Limousin bull making 223p/kg. He was followed by Keith Bowes on 221p, Chris Robinson 219p and John Edgar on 216p/kg.

It was Frank Pickering who sold an enormous Charolais bull weighing 814kg that added up to £1721; Doug Shirt then had a British Blue making £1611 and Graham Stephenson a Saler bull on £1489.

The Black and White trade also held together at over 160p/kg; and the best British Friesian was jointly held by Rosie Dunn and Doug Shirt who both hit 189p/kg.

Next was Ed Hardcastle with a black and white on 184p, Andrew Cook on 182p and Gareth Taylor 180p/kg.

We had a quality show of clean cattle and this section was headed by Pam Gibson with an outstanding heifer making 238p/kg.

Pip Dale then had a heifer on 237p, Mick Thuey 236p and David Oxtoby with the highest priced steer on 235p/kg.

The OTM's were more plentiful this week and made up to a top of 162p for a Limousin heifer from K G Clarke with Wendy Lyle showing another young Limousin cow on 158p/kg.
