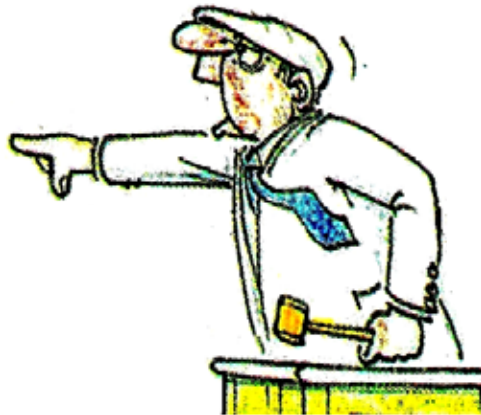

There were only 148 cattle in the market of which 59 were bulls, 51 clean and 38 OTM's.

Keith Bowes had the top price at 228p with Richard Baxter on 227p, Chris Addy 214p and Peter Ownsworth 213p/kg.

On a headage basis Frank Pickering had two enormous bulls add up to £1500 each with Peter Ownsworth on £1,394 and Gareth Taylor £1,327.

The Black and White trade was also slightly better, probably because there was more flesh on the cattle we had and the averages were well over 160p/kg.

Ed Hardcastle had the best British Friesian which questionable had a touch of Continental blood but it made 203p/kg.
