FAT CATTLE

Bank Holidays are still a menace as far as marketing is concerned but we opened up on Monday and had a small show in all three species. There were 65 cattle forward of which 24 were clean, 27 bulls and 14 OTM's.

Trade was similar in the bull section with the Continentals averaging 192p and the highest priced pair came from Keith Bowes making 215p and 210p respectively.

Rosie Dunn then had a nice Limousin make 209p with H Chapman on 198p and Trevor Brown 196p/kg.

On a headage basis Trevor Brown made £1341, Richard Baxter £1309 and Rosie Dunn's bull added up to £1301.

Black and White trade was similar with Guy Cowling showing a Friesian to make 181p.

Amongst the clean cattle, H Walker brought three heifers which topped the market making 204p and 195p. Geoff Wrigglesworth made 190p of his best heifer and John Crossley 178p.

The OTM's made up to a top of 200p for an overage Limousin steer from J H Patchet.
