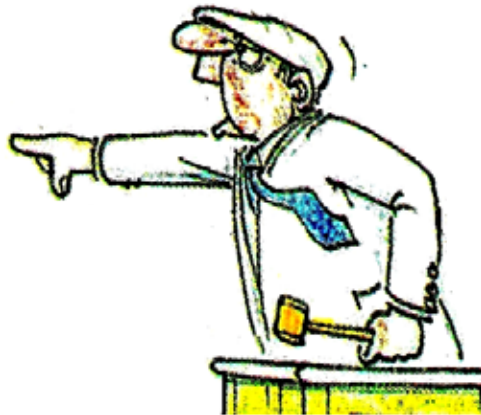

FAT CATTLE

Keeping numbers coming forward are another feature of this very difficult season and Monday was no exception when the fine weather reduced the show to 141 cattle.

Trade held up to give averages for the Continentals of around 204p through the market.

Keith Bowes had a triple triumph taking the top three spots in the young bull price table – two of which made 226p and the third 224p/kg.

Les Thompson followed with a Limousin bull on 223p and Richard Newby had a large homebred Limousin make 221p/kg.

On a headage basis it was Richard Newby who had a giant of a bull make £1659 with Andrew Town making £1550 and John Brewster £1487.

The black and white trade was also pretty good averaging over 160p/kg and the best Friesian came from David Grassam making 186p/kg. Behind him was Doug Shirt on 180p, Ed Wilkin 178p and Bill Cowling 177p/kg.

There were some good clean cattle about and Pam Gibson had two exceptional heifers make 244p and 243p respectively. Behind Pam was John Hall on 242p, Barry Wagstaff with a steer on 241p and Pip Dale on 240p.

There were 14 OTM cattle and these made up to a top of 184p for an overage steer from Steve Oldfield.

Top pen was shown by Nigel Wilde on 209p with Andrew Dobson making 205p and Chris Sowray 187p/kg.

Nigel also had the highest price per head making £85 of his best pen, with Andrew Thompson making £82, R J Greenbank £79 and Chris Sowray £78.

The 79 cull ewes made up to a top of £80 per head.

FAT PIGS

The fat pig trade continues to make progress which it needs to do if feed costs are to be absorbed.

Averages this week were nicely over 120p/kg and we sold 264 pigs through the live auction.

Top spot this week was shared by Andrew Thompson and Graham West both of whom hit 127p/kg for their best pen of gilts. Andrew Thompson then had a run of 10 pens making from 124p to 126p/kg and G C Thornton also had a pen on 124p.

On our deadweight trade we sold 175 pigs last week with the cutters making 163p and the bacon pigs 161p/kg.
