FATSTOCK REPORT MONDAY 10TH SEPTEMBER 2012

FAT CATTLE

What was forecast to be the last day of sunny weather kept our numbers down to barely supportable levels and we ended up with 109 in total.

Trade as a consequence was flying and the Continentals moved up another notch to hit 210p over the market.

In the bull section Pam Gibson produced a quite outstanding Blonde D'Aquitaine bull to make 234p/kg and adding up to £1274. She was followed by Patrick Beal on 229p, Keith Bowes on 228p and Chris Robinson on 221p/kg.

On a headage basis we had a giant of a bull from Doug Shirt weighing 918kg adding up to £1831 which must be a record for us. Patrick Beal had a bull add up to £1602 with Malcolm Summerson on £1541.

Our Black & White trade was equally strong with the best Friesian from Doug Shirt making 199p/kg with Bill Cowling making 182p and R Bayston 179p/kg.

In the Clean Cattle section Les Thompson's Limousin heifer broke the 250p barrier making 254p/kg; Brian Pearson made 250p and then Les Thompson had the highest priced steer on 249p/kg.

Edgar Brothers produced two home bred Limousin heifers to make 244 and 245p respectively.

The OTM trade made up to a top of 188p for an overage Friesian steer from Chris Kirby.

It would be nice to see a good show at York next Monday to reassure our buyers.
