FAT PIG REPORT

Increased numbers forward this week and a trade that was better than expected. The endless supply of cheaper imported pork from across Europe is making it very difficult to compete and the Russians ban on imports is now seriously compounding the problem. Deadweight prices are falling dramatically and look likely to continue for the time being.

However, Tim Garside returned to the helm after his summer vacation and with all buyers active the overall average stayed above 120p with a good number of gilts making over 130p.

Top once again was Andrew Thompson at 135p to T H Motson & Sons Ltd.

Sows remain similar with averages in the mid 50s.
