FAT CATTLE

Unfortunately, but understandably with the weather forecast to break on Monday afternoon, our numbers were badly affected this week and we only had 146 turn up in total.

As a consequence demand was strong and all our Continental averages were well over 200p/kg.

The 90 bulls were headed by Chris Robinson with a Blonde d'Aquitaine on 226p followed by Keith Bowes on 225p, John Edgar 219p and Chris Rook 217p/kg.

On a headage basis John Brewster had 2 massive bulls that added up to £1649 and £1647 respectively.

The Black and White trade was good for the fleshed cattle and the highest price for a British Friesian was shared by Richard Button and Doug Shirt on 196p with Rosie Dunn on 187p and Mark Nicholson 182p/kg.

Doug Shirt's Friesian bull added up to £1447.

There were only 46 clean cattle but the quality was pretty good and top of the list today was Tony Barker with a heifer on 245p, Pam Gibson then had 2 heifers make 243p and 241p respectively with Peter Johnson and Dennis Midgely on 227p.

The highest priced steer came from Wilton Lodge on 226p/kg.

The OTM's were nothing special and held their own.

Let's hope we look forward to more numbers next week.

Trade lifted because of the shortage and averages were back up to 190p/kg.

Mark Lofthouse had the highest priced pen on 233p/kg with Andrew Dobson on 223p and Martin Benson 222p/kg.

On a headage basis Mark again was today's market leader on £98 with David Fox on £97.50, Martin Benson £96.50 and T S Watson £93.50.

There was only a smattering of ewes in and these made up to £91/head.

We moved 421 pigs this week of which 246 came into the live market.

The auction trade hovered around 112p/kg and Andrew Thompson had the top four pens of gilts making 123p-128p/kg.

Fred Horsley also had a pen on 123p with B Blackburn on 121p and Peter Ownsworth 120p.

The deadweight trade has stayed steady and the 175 pigs we marketed were sold at 155p for the cutters and 152p for the bacon pigs.
