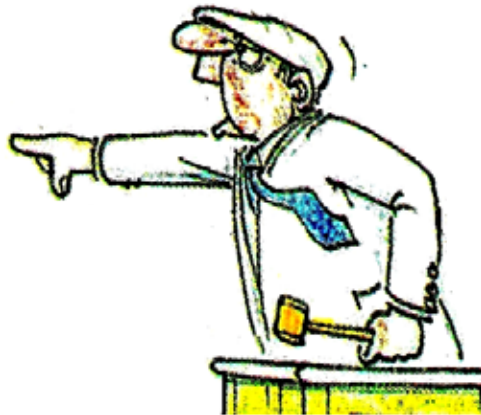

FAT CATTLE

Our new Auctioneer and Fieldsman Scott Ferrie has started the New Year with great enthusiasm and we have had two very decent shows of stock at York.

This Monday there were 221 cattle of which 100 were clean, 86 bulls and 35 OTM's.

Trade was maybe a penny or two down on last week but perhaps this just reflected the quality that came forward.

In the bull section Continentals averages 206p/kg with Keith Bowes topping the poll on 226p followed by H R Wood with a home bred Charolais on 224p and Chris Addy on 223p/kg. Close behind them was Peter Ownsworth with a 690kg bull making 220p/kg.

On a headage basis Millington Grange Estate produced two enormous pedigree Limousins both weighing over 900kg and adding up to £1826 and £1747 respectively.

The Black and White trade was a touch less but the averages were still over 160p/kg.

There were one or two outstanding Friesians the first from Chris Nicholls making 193p, Doug Shirt on 192p and Basil Aconley on 190p/kg.

It was one of the best shows of Clean Cattle in terms of numbers and the league table was shared by David Jackson and the Beevers family both of whom made 234p/kg.

Bernard Henley then had a heifer on 233p with Stephen White on 232p and Gordon Coward 230p. The highest priced steer was shown by David Jackson on 229p/kg.

Scott sold the OTM's and he had some overage Limousins topping out at 220p from H Walker & Son, Stephen White having a steer on 213p and Millington Grange a large heifer on 209p/kg.

All in all it was a successful day and we look forward to more support. Don't forget to give Scott a ring if you want advice on 07801 685667.

FAT SHEEP

Fat sheep numbers have lifted with 659 coming in on Monday.

Scott sold the 541 hogs with an average of 146p/kg which was acceptable considering the way trade fell last week.

The smart smaller sheep were still at a premium and Carl Fawcett topped this week's market on 205p with the Hockley family on 202p, Andrew Dobson 190p and Ian Clough 183p/kg.

On a headage basis Carl Fawcett and Ian Clough both had pens making £78 with Richard Dove on £77.50, the Hockley family £75.50 and David Bristow £75.

Although they are not a great trade, it did hold up throughout the day.

Stephen Burley dispatched 118 ewes making up to a top of £75 and averaging just short of £50 per head.

FAT PIGS

The fat pig trade has taken a serious dip since Christmas and although we moved 430 pigs last week, the results are not great reading.

270 came into the market live on Monday and the auction trade hovered around 100p/kg.

The best gilts were shown by Graham West making 120p with B Blackburn on 114p, C E Stonehouse 110p and Andrew Thompson 109p/kg.

To balance the gilt trade I'm afraid there were plenty of boars struggling to make 86-92p.

On the deadweight we sold 160 pigs with the cutters holding on to 165p/kg and the baconers 160p/kg.
