FAT CATTLE REPORT

This week it was D R & S E Ravis leading the Young Bulls at 210p/kg for their 664kg Linousin. Ed Hardcastle came in equal second at 205p/kg also for a LIM bull scaling 576kg to J & B Fitton Ltd, Richard Henley and G & A Gaythorpe also took 205p/kg to Thompson Wholesale Meat Ltd and A Traves & Son Ltd respectively. J Brewster took the next spot with a British Blue at 606kg realising 203p/kg to Cleveland Meat Co.

D R & S E Ravis also came out on top per head at £1391.08, M & D Nicholson 752kg AAX made £1387.44 to Cleveland Meat Co, Cheryl Edwards British Blue scaled 758kg to £1315.13 he was knocked down to Peter Pearson.

In the Clean trade it was G & J Y Marshall both first and second spots at 258p/kg, 256p/kg both for LIM X heifers scaling 550kg. First to W Fletcher & Son Ltd, Malton then next to John Penny & Sons, Leeds. Edgar Bros LIM steer at 548p/kg realised 243p/kg to C Wastenev & Sons, Sheffield. Wilton Lodge Farms heifers at 616kg and 668kg made 238p/kg, 232p/kg to Thompson Wholesale Meat Ltd and J Penny & Sons respectively.

Per head it was Wilton Lodge Farms at the top at £1546.42 to J Penny & Sons, M G Piercy at £1508.49 for his CHX heifer weighing 666kg to Kurpas Meats PLC, Wilton Lodge Farms next at £1463 to Thompson Wholesale Meat Ltd. Edgar Bros £1427.82 to J Penny & Sons.

OTM cattle were topped at 156p/kg or £1275.10 from M G Piercy to Cleveland Meat Co.

R A Dobson was third in line at 198.9p/kg for 46kg Texels, slightly behind at 198p/kg was H & C W Burkill with their 50kg Texels to John Penny & Sons. Andrew Dobson again at 190p/kg to M & C Meats.
