FAT PIG REPORT

The only way to describe the trade this week was “*on fire.*” Numbers continue to remain very tight and the market place very finely balanced; as a result the bit of extra demand from most buyers resulted in a significant lift, seeing an overall average of over 140p. A good proportion of gilts were achieving between 150-156p and even some of the better bores were up to 140p.

Pig production continues to slowly move into a smaller number of bigger producers hands, who in turn look to the security and stability of deadweight contracts. In turn, the main abattoirs are keen to secure more loyalty and stability of supply. All in all this has meant less pigs on the open market, both for the live auction and spot deadweight, resulting in the current shortfall in the fresh meat sector.

Top spot at 156p was shared this week by A Thompson, P Ownsworth and B Blackburn, purchased by A Traves & Son, Richards of Howden, T H Motson & Sons respectively.

A small number of good sows averaged 72p as this trade seems to have now levelled out from recent falls.

DEFRA have announced that Single Payment Scheme entitlements held by farmers on 31st December 2014 will be rolled forward to the new Basic Payment Scheme to be introduced on 1st January 2015

You need to ensure that you hold sufficient entitlements for your claimable area of farmed land by 31st December 2014

If you hold an excess of entitlements then these will be lost in 2015.

The minimum claim size in 2015 will be 5 hectares.
