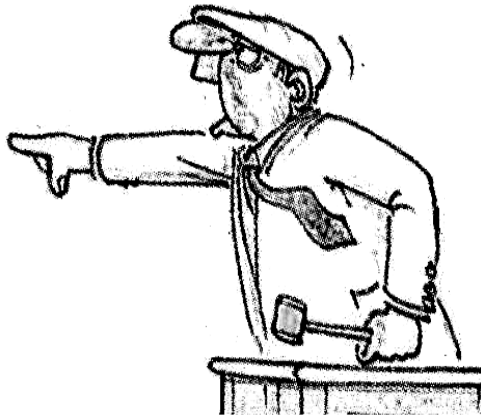

## **FATSTOCK REPORT MONDAY 20<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2012**

### **FAT CATTLE**

We had the best show of the year so far with 257 on parade of which 136 were clean, 107 bulls and 14 OTM's. It is interesting that bulls are in short supply and have been overtaken in numbers by the clean cattle; and this may be as a result of the high price of corn last year which persuaded many to cut their bull stirks.

Trade was strong with the clean cattle dearer than ever averaging 206p through the market, but the bulls were a penny or two off the pace at 195p.

In the bull section I am delighted to announce that Norman Colley topped the poll with an outstanding British Blue bull making 219p; he was followed by Bill Cowling on 218p, Chris Addy 215p and Peter Sawyer 212p/kg.

On a headage basis Doug Shirt had three bulls which made from £1481 to £1612.

Behind Doug came Chris Addy on £1458, John Brewster £1443 and Pete Ownsworth £1431.

The black and white bulls averaged over 150p and the best British Friesian was shown by Gareth Taylor on 187p with Basil Aconley having two bulls make 186p, Alan Sykes was on 183p and Pete Johnson 180p/kg.

However it was the clean cattle that really led the field with Brian Pearson having an outstanding heifer making 236p bought by David Penny.

David also bought the highest priced steer from W Jibson & Son at 221p/kg.

OTM's were scarce this week making up to 145p/kg. With the sort of trade that we are getting at York, more cattle will hopefully come forward.

On a headage basis Mike Wills was top of the list at £103 with G H West on £101.50, Derek Nesom £98.50 and Mike Towse £97.50.
