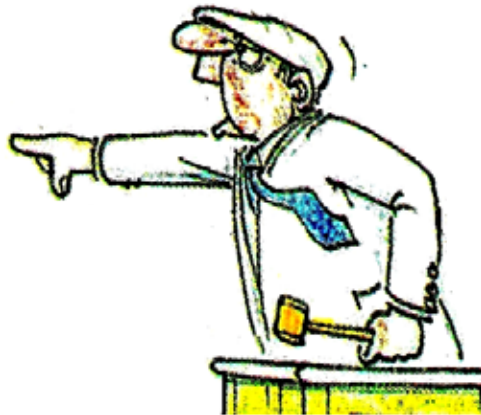

ELLWOOD & CASS SALE – 15th AUGUST 2012.

There was a good crowd of mainly Yorkshire buyers at York Livestock Centre for an attractive sale of more than 170 commercial cattle. Brothers John and Robert Ellwood from Selby sold the entire adult portion of their herd and Maurice Cass from Scalby, who are gradually ceasing milk production, sold a number of milkers and a group of served and maiden heifers, many of them Brown Swiss Crosses. Messrs Cass provided the top price of the day for a fresh second calver giving 36kg which realised 2,150gs to B.H.Wilson & Sons, Green Hamerton, York.

Top price for Messrs Ellwood's milkers was 1,800gs paid twice, firstly for a second calver by Cogent Libra, purchased by Paul Waring, Shiptonthorpe, York and then for a Moet Bandana daughter, taken by the Askham Bryan College, who secured an additional entry from Colin Holtby, Arram, Beverley, who is dispersing his herd as they calve. This was a pedigree second calver Coldharbour Dynasty Lois, by Kelstein Dynasty, who was knocked down for 1,950gs.

The recent poor weather has had some impact on the young stock trade with farmers concerned about likely fodder supplies this coming winter, but there is plenty of interest at present in good quality cattle at profit.
