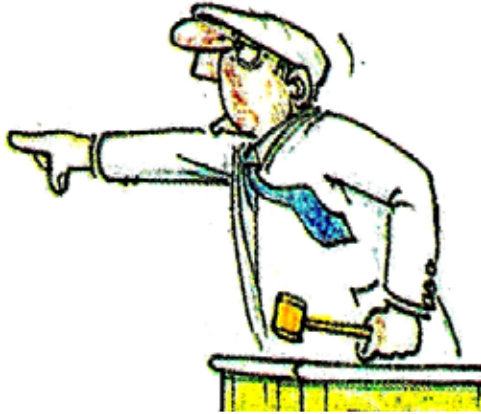

FAT CATTLE MARKET REPORT

Under dreadful snowy conditions, our producers struggled through with a total of 158 fat cattle to include 69 clean, 72 bulls and 17 OT-M's.

Buyers also had a fight to make the journey but virtually all were sat at the ringside by the start of the sale. Trade was a few pennies less but the Continentals all averaged well over 200p/kg through the market.

The young bull table was topped by Keith Bowes who had two outstanding animals making 233p and 220p. Behind him was Steve Oldfield on 213p, then Barry Wagstaff 212p and Ed Hardcastle 209p/kg.

The black and white trade also lagged behind a little compared to last week but Doug Shirt did have a bull weighing 662kg make 195p/kg which would be more than acceptable.

The fat cattle were led this week by Les and John Thompson who had two heifers making 254p and 250p respectively.

Next in line were the Hutchinson family from Wilton Lodge who sold a home bred heifer to make 249p/kg; and then also Pam Gibson on the same figure with two heifers.

The highest priced steer was shown by the Thompsons making 247p/kg.

Scott Ferrie dispatched the OTM's which made up to a top of 226p for an overage but very shapely Belgian Blue heifer from Chris Rook.

Steve Oldfield then had an overage steer on 168p with the dearest Friesian cow coming from Richard Blacker on 125p/kg.

Trade was the opposite to cattle and lifted slightly, averaging 157p/kg.

The top two pens were shown by Carl Fawcett making 221p and 220p respectively. They were followed by Tom Stephenson on 186p, Andrew Dobson 184p and Brian Pearson 177p/kg.

On a headage basis Carl Fawcett hit £80 with Tom Stephenson on £76.50, David Bristow £76 and Nigel Wild £72/head.
