FAT PIG REPORT

Sadly Monday turned into one of those rare nightmare days with a lot bigger show than normal, 2 buyers missing completely and others not wanting any extra. The end result was a poor trade with overall averages struggling to achieve 100p.

It is very worrying at this time of year to have such poor demand and a growing carry forward of pigs on the deadweight system.

Peter Ownsworth did achieve a top price of 120p to Ainsty Farms Direct but other than that there were very few pens that exceeded to 110p market.

Sows remain similar with only the best making 50p.

RED AND GREEN MARKETS October 2014

Earlier in the year we responded to a drop in trade by introducing alternate Red and Green Markets for our Fatstock day and thankfully this served its purpose in increasing the number of buyers around both the cattle and sheep rings.

In recent weeks, numbers have been adversely affected on the Green Market days because many farmer customers are buying in stock at this time of year.
