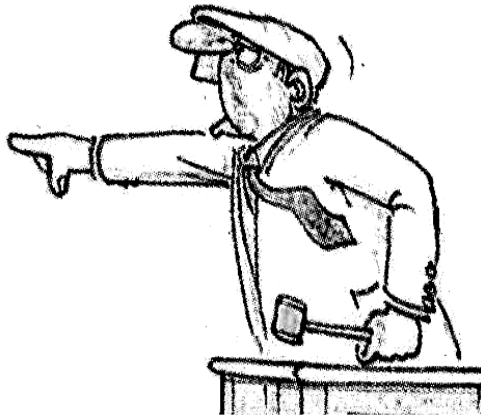

## **FATSTOCK REPORT MONDAY 23<sup>RD</sup> JANUARY 2012**

### **FAT CATTLE**

We are still not at the end of January so it was a relief to get through Monday with no further decline in trade.

The Continentals averages just about 190p through the market which is only 10p down on our record weeks before Christmas.

There were 243 cattle on parade of which 87 were Clean, 123 Bulls and 33 OTM's.

In the bull section Mark Bulmer produced a couple of outstanding British Blue's which made the top price of 224p and 215p/kg.

In-between his bulls, John Edgar had a home-bred Limousin at 219p and Keith Bowes had a British Blue on 116p.

Antony Turnbull, Brian Walker and Richard Newby all produced bulls to make 114p/kg.

On a headage basis Richard Newby's bull added up to £1447 whilst Edward Wilkin took home £1443, Lou Barnard £1439 and Peter Ownsworth £1419.

From the Black and White section Bill Cowling produced the best British Friesian I've ever seen in the market weighing 602kg and making 197p/kg. In second place Andrew Cook had a Friesian on 181p, Doug Shirt 180p and Ian Mercer 174p/kg.

There was a nice show of Clean Cattle led by David Fox who made 230p of his Limousin heifer which was bought by Jeremy Sissons master butcher of Pocklington.

Les Thompson then had two heifers making 225p and 228p bought by Fletchers of Malton and John Penny & Sons.

Stephen White had a heifer on 224p and Geoff Cundall 221p/kg.

The highest priced steer was shown by W Gibson on 210p with Sam Beachall on 209p/kg.

Breaking up cattle were good to sell averaging over 150p/kilo.

The OTM market remains firm and top price today went to Gareth Taylor with an overage Limousin heifer making 190p.

The Beevers family then had a Charolais on 160p with Paul Cammidge on 159p/kg.

The highest priced Friesian was shown by Tony Wake on 136p/kg.

#### **FAT SHEEP**

There was a slightly better show of 320 sheep in the market of which 247 were hoggs and 73 cull ewes. Trade continues to be bullish averaging well over 200p/kg.

The top pens were shown jointly by Andrew Dobson and Chris Robinson on 228p/kg with K Smith and D Green on 220p, Brian Pearson 219p and Mrs Astley on 218p/kg.

On a headage basis Mike Wills from Pateley managed to produce some 47kg lambs to make £99.50; Chris Robinson made £99, H Sergeant £98 and M Kendra £95.

The ewe trade averaged £87 up to a top of £108.

The deadweight market absorbed 240 pigs this week with the cutters making 148p and the bacon pigs 144p/kg.
