The cattle ring was a hive of excitement. With the young bulls in general having more flesh the trade reflected that with the average up 6p on the week.

This time it was J Dale's bull selling to 230p/kg to Mark Fitton. Chris Robinson at 214p/kg, G T Taylor 211p/kg to Peter Pearson. Healey Bros 211p/kg to Mark Fitton, W T Mennell 209p/kg and Doug Shirt 208p/kg both to Peter Pearson, Sam Beachell at 206p/kg to J & B Fitton.

On a headage basis it was Doug Shirt at £1676.60 (twice), £1548 to Peter Pearson, Gareth Taylor £1507.18, C W Walker & Son £1505.43 again to Peter Pearson.

The clean cattle were slightly easier this week, more could have been sold.
