STRONG CLASSES FOR SPRING FATSTOCK SHOW

A great show of 288 Cattle were on show this week with vendors traveling from as far as the Scottish borders. 138 Clean, 129 Bulls and 22 Cows.

There was a tremendous entry of 40 cattle for the Spring Show which this year was judged by Tony Wastney, master local butcher.

In the Young Bull section it was David and Les England from Winttingham who swept the board with first place in both the light and heavy classes.

Their lightweight bull took the Bull Championship with the reserve going to the second placed lightweight from Peter Sawyer.

The Champion Bull duly made the top price of 258p/kg before being knocked down to Stephen Swales of ABS Meats.

England Brothers' heavyweight prize winner made 248p/kg and added up to a staggering £1643.

Second in the heavyweight class was David Etherington with the third prize going to Guy Cowling.

In the Clean classes the competition was fierce but as you would expect from our master local butcher, Tony favoured the lightweight classes.

The winner of the light heifer class was Pam Gibson and in second place was Les Thompson.

The positions were reversed in the light steer class where the Thompson family produced an outstanding Limousin bullock which had been Champion at the Hawes Suckler Sale last autumn; and it was this beast that went on to take the Supreme Championship making 270p/kg before being bought by David Penny.

The Reserve Champion was Pam Gibson's lightweight heifer and that made 266p/kg also bought by Penny's.

Highest price of the day went to Pam Gibson's third prize heifer which only weighed 370kg but made 276p which is a new record for our market.

The heavy heifer class was won by D & J Oxtoby and the heavy steer class by David Jackson who took first and second place with two outstanding specimens.

All in all it was a highly successful day and our thanks to all those who competed.

The OTM section was topped on a head basis at £1809.94 for a Limousin X cow from Robert Neill, Upper Nisbet, Scottish Borders a great start for his first time here. D & J Oxtoby average Limousin bull-ock made 256p/kg, on of the dearest prices yet.

It was a busy day in the sheep market with our Spring Show. With 1136 sheep being sold.

The 105 Spring Lambs averaged 282.8p/kg (£111.93)

FAT PIG REPORT

The biggest show of pigs for a long time, perhaps boosted by the fact that next week is Easter bank holiday.

The heavy snow falls in parts of South and West Yorkshire have had a distribution effect on deliveries and retail shopping which in turn has taken the edge off the trade, but hopefully only short term. But despite more limited demand from some buyers the overall average remarkably showed no change on the previous week at 120p/kg. The top price this week went to N G Brankley & Sons from Hull with a pen of 90kg gilts at 133p bought by Taste Traditions Ltd. These were closely followed by some more 90kg gilts from C E Stonehouse at 132p to M & C Meats.

Sow trade remains constant at an average of 65p/kg with the best up to 68p/kg
