FAT CATTLE REPORT

A tremendous show of 232 cattle of which 116 were clean, 73 Bulls and 43 OTM's.

Trade was a lot dearer on last week with all classes up.

The continental X bulls averaged 213.4p/k, the top price of the day was from Keith Bowes at 238p/k sold to Mark Fitton.

Frank Pickering with a Charolais X bull made the most per head at £1675.08, with R Sellers not far behind at £1648.27.

The Black and White trade was stronger averaging 176.7p/k.

Top of the day was Edward Hardcastle at 216p/k closely followed by Basil Aconley at 206p/k and Gareth Taylor at 204p/k.

The continental X clean averaged 212.3p/k with all classes keenly sought after.

John Thompson had a British Blue making 259p/k followed by Pam Gibson at 251p/k.

It was Maxwell Bros at £1524.25 who had the top price per head.

Our OTM trade remains strong with a Limousin X making 210p/k with the sale averaging 138.7p/k

FAT PIG REPORT

The story this week has to be about quality and the premium this achieved through the live market. An exceptional pen of 84kg cutter weight gilts from Mark Horsley sold for 144p to M & C Meats, and a pen of 107kg bacon weight gilts, also from Mark, made 137p (£146.31 per head) to Taste Tradition.

At the other end of the quality scale, there was nothing to be had under 100p per kilo, with a pen of Gloucester Old Spot bred gilts making 105p.

Overall, the trade was again up on the previous week, this time by 4p per kilo as all buyers keenly contested what was on offer. There is plenty of demand for more pigs to come forward.

Sows were also up again on the previous week, with a top price of 68p per kilo.

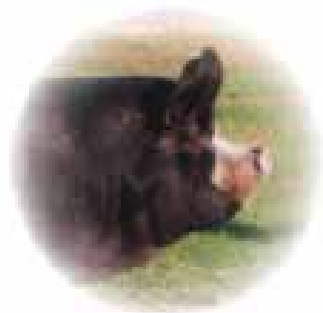
