FAT PIG REPORT

As prices in mainland Europe begin to increase it must mean good news for us; both bacon pigs and cutter prices are falling and are likely to fall week on week while the processors find a balancing act between European imports and buying GB product.

Monday's market mirrored this with cutters and bacon pigs subdued. Top price of the morning went at both Andrew Thompson and Cliff West at 135p to T H Motson & Sons Ltd and Taste Tradition respectively.

The sow trade remains stable with an average this week similar to the last at 66p.
