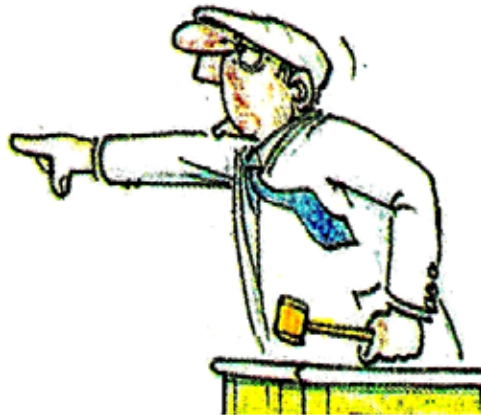

I may be an old fashioned work horse but bank holidays are a menace in business; and they certainly do disrupt our fatstock markets.

Nevertheless we had 55 cattle on Monday and a sensible trade throughout.

The 40 young bulls averaged 197p for the Continentals and 162p for the black and whites.

The top young Limousin bull of the day came from David Voakes making 221p with Stuart Jackson and Barry Wagstaff both sharing 210p for their British Blues. Bill Cowling and Edward Wilkin also shared third place on 209p/kg.

On a headage basis Ed produced a Limousin bull to make £1543 with Stuart Jackson on £1580 and David Voakes £1353.

The black and white bulls this week were topped by Doug Shirt on 198p with Andrew Cook on 182p and Rosie Dunn 174p/kg.

The clean cattle were headed by young Bill Massey who had come over from Cheshire with an Angus steer to make 211p with David Voakes on 209p and R Stephenson 196p/kg.

FAT PIGS

This is perhaps the only livestock sector that was relatively unaffected by the holiday and we sold 336 pigs last week of which 166 came into the live market on Monday. The trade thankfully is pretty good and the averages were just short of 120p/kg. Top pen was shown by Andrew Thompson on 125p with Fred Horsley on 124p and Pete Ownsworth 119p/kg.

Deadweight we moved 170 pigs with the cutters making 156p and the bacon pigs 152p/kg.
