The top grossing lamb this week was from Sam Beachell at £87.50 and £85 to A B S Meats, Andrew Dobson at £83.50 to John Penny & Sons, Leeds. Steve Barnes and J W & J H Galtrey & Son at £82 to J & B Fitton Ltd and John Penny & Sons. Garrowby Estate Farms at £79.50 to A Traves & Son Ltd.
